(Win that defined a season and aided in the establishment or further development of the program)

1928 - Ruston (32-0)	In a battle of the only two undefeated teams in north Louisiana, Winnfield proved to be the better and did it by a decisive margin.
1933 - Neville (7-6)	This game was played on Neville's home field and is considered by some to be one of the biggest wins of the 1930s or 1940s.
1955 - Neville (13-12)	WHS played in Class A and only won four games all year. Neville went on to win the Class AA state title; that schools first state title.
1961 - Ruston (21-6)	This win snapped a 24-year winless streak to Ruston and kept the hopes of an undefeated regular season alive.
1966 - Jena #2 (33-13)	After losing to Jena 19-14 in the regular season finale, the Tigers came back four days later, defeated Jena in a tie-breaker game and earned a spot in the playoffs.
1968 - Winnsboro (21-7)	Winnfield knocked off the No. 1 ranked Wildcats and the state runner-up from the season before to claim the district title in the district finale. The Tigers either took the title with a win or stayed home in the playoffs with a loss.
1971 - Natchitoches (14-0)	This was a tight defensive battle between two Class AAA Top Ten ranked district foes. The Tigers scored on two 70+ yard electrifying runs - one a punt return, the other a run from scrimmage. The win essentially secured the district title for Winnfield in this undefeated regular season.
1971 - Houghton (20-13)	The first quarter final round win in the program's history; this win came on a touchdown in the final minute of the game after the Tigers failed to score from inside the Houghton 10 yard line the series before.
1976 - Catholic, BR (30-13)	This surprisingly convincing semi-final round win sent the Tigers to the Class AAA finals.
1978 - Haynesville (19-16)	This one was for the district title and it took four field goals in overtime to settle.
1979 - St. Louis (14-9)	St. Louis had been ranked No. 1 in the polls since the second week of the season. This win came in the regional round of the playoffs.
1980 - Minden (29-21)	The Tigers played in Class AA, while Minden was the eventual Class AAA state champs.
1981 - Jonesboro-Hodge (34-29)	After trailing 29-0 in second quarter, the Tigers staged the largest comeback in school history to win the district title.
1982 - E. D. White (50-8)	Semi-final round whipping avenged a semi-final round loss to EDW the year before. The Tigers rolled to a 35-0 lead at the half, in a game that was delayed one day by flood-producing rains.
1982 - John Curtis (23-14)	This was for the Class AA state title and was the first and only state title won by Winnfield on the playing field.
1988 - Jonesboro-Hodge (13-12)	In 1988 Winnfield only won four games, but one of those was against the eventual Class AA state champs.
1989 - Jonesboro-Hodge (14-6)	Jonesboro repeats as the Class AA state champs, but only after Winnfield won this season opener.
2000 - Ouachita Christian (28-14)	The Tigers traveled to Monroe and knocked off the eventual Class AA state champs.
2003 - Jena #2 (56-30)	Winnfield had won a 41-38 shootout during the regular season. This 1st round playoff win sent the program to the second round for the 4th time in 5 years.

Select your top 7 Most Disappointing Losses

1923 - Warren Easton (0-7)	These were the only point allowed in the only loss of a 9-1 season.
1928 - Bolton (0-7)	This loss knocked the Tigers out of playoff contention and was the only loss of the highest scoring team of the pre-1960 era.
1961 - Tallulah (0-12)	After going through the season undefeated and ranked No. 1 in the polls, this loss came in the opening round of the playoffs.
1966 - Jena (13-19)	In a season that turned the program around, the Tigers won 8 straight and needed only a win over Jena in the season finale to secure the district
1971 - South Lafourche (0-10)	After going through the season undefeated and progressing further than any previous Tiger team, this loss came in the Class AAA title game labeled the "Mud Bowl" by the local paper.
1976 - Jesuit, Sp. (0-7)	In the Class AAA title game played at Stokes-Walker, the Tigers only allowed one pass completion, but that one went for the only score of the game.
1978 - St. Louis (20-21)	After posting an undefeated regular season, this Tiger team's season ended prematurely in this QF round loss at home.
1980 - Mansfield (14-21)	The Tigers began the season by defeating Minden, the eventual Class AAA state champs. However, this district loss effectively kept this team out of the Class AA playoffs.
1981 - E. D. White (7-15)	After winning 11 straight, the Tigers fell one game short of the Class AA title game with this loss.
1991 - Jonesboro-Hodge (35-38)	This loss came in the season finale and was for the district title. The scored changed hands eight times.
1993 - Bossier (12-41)	At the time, this was the second most points ever allowed by a Tiger team in a playoff loss.
1994 - Springhill (6-44)	After posting an undefeated regular season and a first round playoff win, the Tigers were shut down in the second round of the playoffs.
1995 - McCall (18-78)	In this regular season loss the Tigers gave up the most points ever by a Tiger team.
1995 - Jennings (0-20)	After Anthony Thomas had a career game vs. North Caddo the week before, Thomas and the Tigers were shut down in the second round.
1999 - Notre Dame, Crowley (13-41)	After opening the season with a 9-2 record, the Tigers ended the season by giving up the second most pts. ever allowed at home in the playoffs.
2000 - Westlake (6-41)	After posting an undefeated regular season and first round playoff win the Tigers got blown out in the quarterfinals.
2001 - Many (16-24OT)	Class AA Many came to Winnfield and defeated Class AAA Winnfield. This was only the second loss by Winnfield to Many in that 22 game series.
2001 - E. D. White (38-42)	After staking an 18-0 first qtr lead, the Tigers fell behind in the 4th qtr. only to take the lead with a minute to go on a 70+ yard touchdown pass; but, EDW pulled this win out in the final seconds of the game on an equally improbable scoring pass.
2004 - Oak Grove (34-47)	The Class AAA Tigers went to Class A Oak Grove and got out played.
2004 - Iowa (0-43)	This is the second widest margin of defeat in a playoff game in Tiger football history. Plus, the loss came against a team that got blown out the next week in a 34-9 loss to Notre Dame.
2006 - Caldwell (0-55)	Winnfield held a 20-3-1 series record coming into this game, so the Spartans enjoyed ringing up the points.

Select your top 7 Game-changing Plays

1955 vs. Neville	Brooks Broussard's 80 yd. TD run on final play of the game enabled Class A Winnfield to upset Class AA Neville in the year Neville won their first state title.
1965 vs. Natchitoches	With six seconds to go in the game Gary Green threw a 30-yard pass into the end zone to Wayne Wood, who shoved his way between two Natchitoches defenders to haul in the pass and secure the 19-14 win.
1968 vs. Winnsboro	Randy Poisso's 85 yd return of second half kickoff was a huge momentum boost in this win over then no. 1 ranked Winnsboro.
1971 vs. Natchitoches	Alan Carter's 82 yard punt return just before the half broke a 0-0 tie in a win that effectively gave the Tigers the district title against Top Ten opponent Natchitoches.
1971 vs. Haughton	This Steve Adams to Randy Parker 14 yard TD pass in the final minute of this quarterfinal round playoff game pulled this win out just when it seemed this undefeated season would end.
1971 vs. Hahnville	On fourth down from the Hahnville 11, Steve Adams connected with Greg Wagoner for a touchdown to give the Tigers a 14-13 lead they maintained the rest of the game to secure a spot in the Class AAA title game.
1978 vs. Haynesville	Any of the four FGs in OT by Tommy Latham allowed WSHS to win the Dist. 1-AA crown.
1981 vs. Jonesboro-Hodge	In Winnfield's biggest comeback win ever, a 69-yard TD pass from Greg Powell to Kevin Collins in the 4th qtr. pulled the Tigers to within 3 pts. of J-H in the fourth quarter.
1982 vs. Springhill	In this first round playoff game, Benny Mitchell returned a punt 70 yards for a touchdown to give Winnfield a 14-0 lead. On this rain-soaked field, Mitchell's touchdown gave the Tigers early momentum that they held onto in this narrow 14-12 win.
1982 vs. John Curtis (1)	On the Tigers second possession of the game, Thomas King broke a 74 yard TD run on first down to give Winnfield a 14-0 lead.
1982 vs. John Curtis (2)	Garlon Powell's 56 yard TD run on WSHS's third possession of the game moved the Tigers lead to 20-0.
1982 vs. John Curtis (3)	Garlon Powell's 25-yard FG with four minutes to go in the title game gave WSHS a 9-point lead and a whole lot of insurance.
1983 vs. Jonesboro-Hodge	An 82-yard HB pass from Garlon Powell to Darrell Smith in the closing minutes of the game allowed WSHS to take a 19-14 win and the district title.
2001 vs. E. D. White	John C. Jones, Jr. 74 yd. TD pass to Antwun Barnes in the final minute of this playoff loss. This is the only play on this list that came in a losing effort.

1923 (9-1-0)	Recorded the most wins and scored the most points (246) of any Stokes-coached team. Only allowed 7 pts. (Grady Newton, Benny Parker and Herbert Wasson).
1928 (9-1-0)	This talent-laden team scored the most points of any team prior to the 1960s (385). Their only loss was a 7-0 decision to Bolton. (Kenneth Teegarden, Byron "Chuck" Skains, Gabe Durham, Clebe Maxey, Garfield Gimber and Frank Brewer).
1948 (9-2-0)	Tied school record for most wins and scored second most points (242 pts.) of any team up to that time. (Durwood Swilley, John William Warner, Waymon Swilley, Jack Myrick and Sam Emerson).
1961 (11-1-0)	Second Tiger team to post an undefeated regular season. Earned a no. 1 ranking in the Class AA polls and set school records for most wins and points scored, among others. (Wayne McFarland, Don Jones, David Adams, Mike Tinnerello, Jimmy Bolton and Carroll Long).
1968 (9-3-0)	Had to defeat no. 1 ranked Winnsboro to even get in the playoffs where they recorded the school's first playoff win. (Randy Poisso, Hershhal Long, Mike Parker, Doug Allen, Charles Eagles and Tommy Tinnerello).
1971 (13-1-0)	First Tiger team to play for a state championship on the field. Set numerous defensive and kick return records. Highest scoring team in school history up to that time (467 pts.). Class AAA state runner up. (Alan Carter, Lionel Johnson, Greg Wagoner, James Hutchins, John Wayne Williams, Steve Adams, Jerry Keen, Eddie Jenkins, Randy Strickland, Paul Larson, Roy Cotton and John C. Jones, Sr).
1976 (11-3-0)	This team peaked in the playoffs, where they took three convincing wins and hosted the Class AAA title game at home. They were the Class AAA State runnerup. (Nathan Johnson, Lyn Bankston, Dennis Brown, Donnie Purser, Woody Grigg, Rankin Curry and Buck Carter).
1978 (12-1-0)	This team posted the fourth undefeated regular season and set scoring records along the way. Became the first team to score more than 500 points. 1979 (11-2-0)	The only loss this team sustained in the AA ranks was in the semifinals to John Curtis. (Jeffery Dale, Tim Jordan, Craig Cummings, Ricky Chatman, Kevin Poisso, Tommy Campbell, Craig Cummings, Chip Little, Mark Hennigan, Kevin Wagoner and Tommy Latham).
1981 (11-2-0)	One of only five Tiger teams to reach the semifinals. After winning 11-straight, this team dropped a 7-pt. decision to E. D. White in the semi-finals. (Greg Powell, Ken Maloy, Tommy Latham, Perry Myles, Thomas King, Doyce Gorham, Ken Maloy, Andy White, Garlon Powell, Jess Grigg, Marcel Mills, Earl Funches and Richard Williams).
1982 (13-1-0)	The Class AA state champions. Set school record for most points scored, among others. (Marcel Mills, Thomas King, Garlon Powell, Chester Brinson, Johnny Williams, Jay Huckaby, Jess Grigg, Todd Wold, Glen Nelson, Randy Johnson, Sampson Collins and Benny Mitchell).
1994 (11-1-0)	This team posted the fifth undefeated regular season. One of only five Tiger teams to score over 400 pts. (Anthony Thomas, Brian Garrett, R. C. Williams, John Joseph, Derrek Craft, Kendall Wooten, Brock Grantadams, David Gaar, DeCarlus Pittman and Robert Anderson).
2000 (12-1-0)	This team posted the school's sixth undefeated regular season and advanced to the QF round of the playoffs. (Freddie King, Zan Johnson, Ray Brown, Chuck Ball, Christopher Yerby and Andrew Smith).
2001 (10-2-0)	This team set defensive records in route to a 9-win regular season. (Zan Johnson, Jemayal Phillips, Andrew Smith, Terrance Wade, Antwun Barnes, Seth Howell and John C. Jones, Jr.)
